Dear EMS Community:

Please find enclosed the **MCC- PSTF EMS Course Schedule for Spring 2007** and a **Position Announcement for EMS Instructors**. Please distribute these documents to anyone who might be interested in the courses or part time employment with MCC Basic EMS Education.

The scheduled course offerings are similar to the last few semesters. We try to design the schedule to provide a variety of locations and dates; however we have been faced with declining enrollment in traditional recertification programs as EMS providers transition to the CME Based Recertification program. Because of that decline in EMT Recertification students, a decision was made to offer all those courses at the PSTF.

**Operation Management for EMS** will be offered again in the spring semester. This course will be a hybrid of classroom and internet instruction with about one third of the course being taught on-line. The intended audience for this course is EMS Officers who are looking to become more familiar with public health law, federal regulations, other public safety professions and the future direction of EMS. **There is not an EMT-Intermediate Original course this spring** because of on going revisions with the state certification exam. A decision was made that the current exam does not fairly assess the written objectives of the course and to offer the course to students would be a disservice. We are awaiting revisions to the EMT-Intermediate test bank before we offer the course again. We are hopeful that these changes will be made in time for a fall offering. We will offer an EMT-Intermediate Recertification course for those students who need it.

**Notes:**

- A- Challenge practical exams for these courses will be established at the first meeting based on needs of the students and the program
- B- Students must be enrolled in the CME Based Recertification program with the NYS DOH. This course includes 24 hours of core content and 6 hours of "optional" education.
- C- Students must attend the first session on 1/18/06. Other classroom sessions are based on student need. The majority of topics are taught using SUNY- Learnet.
- D- Students must be enrolled in the CME Based Recertification program with the NYS DOH. This course includes the "core content" for the paramedic level.
